
MENU:

SECURITY:

We are very sensitive in this aspect as it guarantees the safety of children. The school employs three Askaris that are charged with ensuring that the school is free of intrusion.

Among others, CCTV cameras are installed at major vulnerable spots of the school and a wall perimeter fence that encompasses the school premises.

The askaris are deployed with metal detectors to ensure that no weapon is smuggled into the school premises.

ACCOMMODATION:

Alakara Junior Academy and Play Centre has well-equipped boarding facilities to cater for full time and weekly boarding facilities that allow parents to take their children in infant section home on Friday evenings at 5:00pm and return then on Monday mornings at 7:00am.



TRANSPORT (Optional):
